***Rodeo will follow NHSRA Rule Book***

***CHSRF Board will make all final decisions on rule infractions and/or Code of Conduct issues that may arise.***

- Consumption of alcohol, cannabis, tobacco, vaping or any non-prescription or banned substances by contestants is strictly prohibited!!! Zero Tolerance!
- Animal abuse of any kind will not be tolerated! Zero Tolerance!
- Abusive conduct directed at rodeo officials, committee members or volunteers will not be tolerated!
- If a discrepancy arises within arenas, contestant will approach the arena director of that specific arena then they will proceed to Judge & CHSRF Board.
- Any fines handed out during CHSRF will go to Provincial Secretary/ Treasurer to be paid and then individual Province will collect from contestant/family.
- CHSRF Committee & the Keystone Centre are **NOT** responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- SECURITY WILL BE ON SITE AT ALL TIMES.
- Parking will be in your Team / Provinces, if you wanted to park with a friend you must show up together, no savings spots. You will have an awning width space as laid out by parking attendants.
- Day Parking for those choosing to house their horses elsewhere for the night will be located in parking lot south of the main building ramps – all will be marked – Zero parking at unloading area.
- Day Parking for spectators will be on the west side of Westoba Ace Arena (indoor arena) alongside 18<sup>th</sup> street.
- Dress code while in vicinity of the arena for all contestants.
- Contestants must have back numbers on at all times from start of event until the conclusion.
- NO TYING TO TRAILERS
- NO HORSES IN PARKING AREAS
- Tack stalls are provided & will be shared within Provinces.
- All pets **MUST** be on a leash at all times
- Canteen & food vendors on site inside building.
- Trade Show will be located inside building as well as outside the Enns Brothers Arena
- Garbage bins will be provided thru grounds, please leave your campsite in the same order it was when you pulled in.
- Washrooms & showers will be located inside building near Westoba Ace Arena
- Turn-Out Fees will be applied after July 20<sup>th</sup> [www.mhsra.ca](http://www.mhsra.ca) – policy, producers & operations

- 3 go – rounds for main performance.
- **DRAW** – Draw will be made the night before each performance. Draw will be posted by 6am the day of said performance. A minimum of 3 re-rides will be drawn in the rough stock events only (Junior & Senior). In the case of re-ride the same stock rule doesn't apply (Junior & Senior)
- Order of go 1<sup>st</sup> day in program, reverse 2<sup>nd</sup> day, Saturday Barrels / Poles – random draw, timed events slowest to fastest
- Rough Stock will be determined how stock is loaded – no set order.
- Shooting events – one shoot only.
- Outdoor arena takes preference.
- Team roping, tie-down roping & breakaway roping will be 1 loop.
- Raking after 5 on barrels & poles on paper
- Warm up pen available inside & outdoor
- GO-ROUNDS: Prizes to the winners of every event to each round.
- Saddles: Awarded to the High Point Boy & Girl in Junior & Senior.
- Scholarships: Event Champions will receive a \$250 Scholarship, the High Point Boy & Girl will receive a \$500 Scholarship.
- The Canadian Professional Rodeo Association will be awarding a Permit Membership to the Champion & Reserve Champion of the Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding, Tie-Down Roping, Steer Wrestling, Breakaway Roping, Barrel Racing, Team Roping & Bull Riding. HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION ONLY.
- The Canadian Cowboys Association will be awarding a Membership to the Champions of the Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding, Tie-Down Roping, Steer Wrestling, Breakaway Roping, Barrel Racing, Team Roping and Bull Riding. BOTH JUNIOR HIGH & SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION.
- Only 1 Membership per contestant per Association.
